A.2 BRIEFING

There will be a competitor briefing on the patio at 09.30. Please email any questions on Sis up to the night before to racecaptain@bhyc.org.uk

Any Q&A will be communicated via WhatsApp or at the briefing.

A.3 ONSHORE AND LAUNCHING

The club will open at 7.30 and be able to receive competitors from 8.00. On arrival – please put your dinghy in the correct dinghy park: ILCAs, Tera Pro and Feva in the West Dinghy Park; Tera Sport and Coached Fleet in the East Dinghy Park.

Registration and the tally board will be located in the club house. Please register your attendance on arrival. Sailors must "tally on" before launching and "tally off" straight away when they return to the shore.

Please do not launch until you are advised to do so by an event official.

A parent or guardian (or someone designated to be in Loco Parentis) of each participant under 18 must remain on site at all times while their child is on site or racing.


A.4 TIDAL INFORMATION (TIMES ARE BST)

Date: 2 November: Approx high water Bembridge 11.59 (3.3m). We are able to launch and recover 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ hrs either side of HW.

A.5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

It is our intention is to run up to four back-to-back races based on the provisional schedule of races below. Fleet groupings are subject to review when the final number of entrants is known.

The start of one fleet will be the warning signal for the next.

Races will be back to back with the next race starting as soon as possible after the last boat finishes for each fleet. The start order of subsequent races may be varied.

A.6 STARTS

A.6.1 Starting procedure:

Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26 (5-4-1-go).

The Race Officer may hail "Stand By" shortly ahead of the five-minute warning signal for each start.

A.6.2 Start Line:

All races will start from a committee boat. The start line will be an imaginary line between an orange flag on the committee and the outer distance mark which will be a buoy with a BHYC pennant.

A.6.3 Time limit for starting:

A boat starting later than five minutes after her starting signal will be scored as 'did not start'

A.7 COURSE INSTRUCTIONS

A.7.1 The course will be a windward/leeward course as shown in the diagrams below. All marks will be rounded to port. The shape and direction of mark roundings with be advised as follows:

The course board will be displayed at the committee boat/race box at or prior to the preparatory signal.

Marks will be inflatable marks with the following colours as shown on the course diagrams. Any changes to mark colours will be announced at the briefing.

Windward Mark ILCA, Tera Pro and Feva – Orange Inflatable Windward Mark Tera Sport and Tera Coached Regatta – Yellow inflatable Leeward Mark all fleets - Orange Inflatable

A.7.2 ROUNDS /LAPS

The number of rounds/laps will be displayed on a board on the Committee Boat at or prior or to the warning signal.

Races may be shortened in accordance with RRS rule 32.2.

A.8 FINISH

The Finish Line will be an imaginary line between a Blue flag on the Committee and the Outer Distance Mark which will be a yellow pillar buoy.

Boats that have finished shall keep clear of the finish line.
